Thank you for your response and for clarifying that no Aquifer Protection Permit (APP) application or Determination of Applicability (DOA) has been submitted for the proposed EValution Energy project.

I am trying to better understand the permitting process.

If a proposed industrial facility may have discharges that could impact an aquifer, is the project required to either:

- submit an APP application, or
- submit a Determination of Applicability (DOA) for ADEQ to determine whether an APP is required?

Or are there circumstances where neither submission would be required?
